Dear Parents/Carers,

We are unfortunately in the financial position that we need to increase the cost of breakfast club and afterschool club. The increase in costs is due to staff wages, resources, heating and fuel and food costs as well. We have never increased the prices before because we know that many of you rely on both provisions and we understand just how difficult it can be to cope with increasing prices. However, as it stands we are not taking enough money to cover the costs of the provisions and are therefore forced into this situation.

From September 2023 the new charges for Breakfast Club and After School Club will be:

Breakfast Club - £3.00 per child, children entitled to free school meal funding will not be charged. After School Club - £6.50 until 5pm; £7.50 until 5.55pm (5.25pm Friday)

We have made our prices as competitive as we can and we are still much lower than our local primary schools.


The year 6 leavers party will take place in school on Tuesday 25th July from 4.30 until 6.00 pm.
