Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for keeping to our risk assessment and being 2 metres apart when you come to school to drop off and collect children. Locally there are still quite a lot of cases of Covid-19; some schools nearby have had to close bubbles due to cases in school. Please continue to be vigilant in following the Government guidance. Staff in school are self-testing twice a week using Lateral Flow tests, if you would like to test yourselves and your family the tests can be easily ordered from <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests> they are free of charge and are really easy to use.

Thank you to everyone who raised money for the sponsored read, one of our children raised £180 all by herself, amazing! We have £434 that you have raised; we will also get a contribution from the book supplier as well so we will have about £600 to spend on new books for our library.
