Dear Parents/Carers,



Welcome back to school for our summer term I hope that you all had a lovely Easter break with your families; now that restrictions are being relaxed I hope that you all feel a little bit more hopeful for the future. I am hopeful that we will be able to pencil in events like Sports days and perhaps even a summer Beach Party, I'm keeping a really close eye on the government advice and will let you know if we are able to do

things like this. We still have a strict risk assessment in place which includes the one way system around school for drop off and pick up and families standing two metres apart in the line: frequent hand washing and hand gelling throughout the day and children having their own personal equipment, rather than sharing.

I have received a complaint about parents parking on the roads near to school. I have replied that parents do need to drop their children off safely and need to use the local streets to park while they do this. Please make sure that you do not park on the yellow zigzag lines outside school. Please could you also make sure that you park safely and that people's drives are not blocked so that our residents are not affected.
