
Please make sure that you book after school club in advance using the school spider app, if this doesn't work for any reason please ring school in advance for the following week. We have to ensure that adult-child ratios are correct; once we are full we cannot accept more children unless I book another adult. We can easily book extra staff as long as we know how many children are in. The cost is £5 per session per child. After school club runs from 3.20 until 5.55 Monday to Thursday and 3.20 until 5.25 on Friday. Please note the Friday finishing time. If children are regularly collected later than 5.25 this will incur an extra charge of £5 and it may be that we will not be able to accept your booking for Fridays in the future.
