Dear Parents/Carers,

Just a reminder that Friday 30th April is an INSET day for school, school reopens on Tuesday 4th May.

It is vitally important that you let school know if you are not picking up your child and have asked a friend, neighbour or other family member. This is particularly important for After School Club collection. We will not be able to let an unknown adult collect your child, this is to ensure the safety of all children. You can message on Dojo, ring the school mobile for After school Club or ring the school office during school hours if someone new is collecting your child; it is also useful if they have a key word or fact that we can check at collection point.

Stockport Local Authority would like your help. Following the Local Authority's recent consultation on the High Needs Funding block of the Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG), (this is the money that the Local Authority use for children with Special Educational Needs) they are now working on proposals based on the feedback they received.

I can then send your views to the Local Authority on your behalf. This will help to shape the future of SEND inclusion and services for the future.

What does the word 'inclusion mean to you, your child and your family? It can be one word, sentence, a page of as long or as short as you want. There are no right and no wrong answers, it's individual to everyone. It can be about one area of life or all of it, say what you think.
