

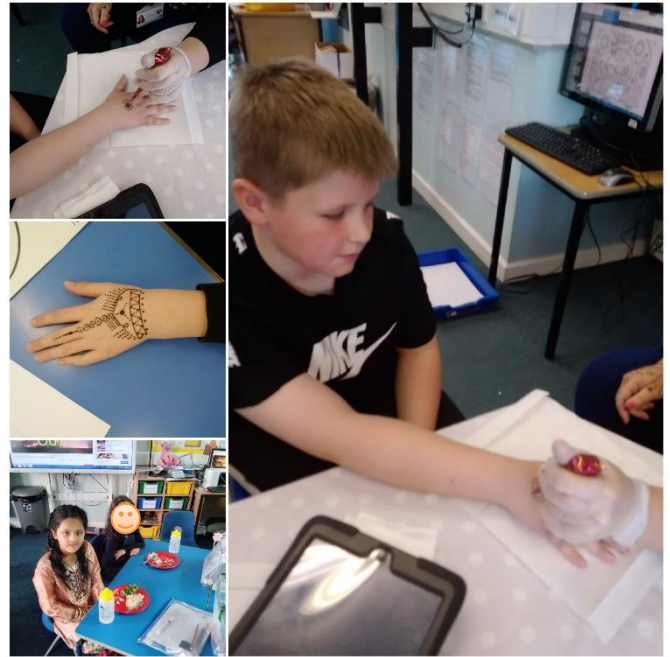
Ladybridge Weekly News
