Dear Parents/Carers,

We are really excited to take years 1 to 5 to Thornbridge Hall. The children will all be carrying out geography field work and learning about urban and country landscapes and features. They will also have a lovely fun day learning outside the classroom.

These are the things that you need to know:

- Please make sure that you have filled out and signed the consent letter.
- Your child will need to wear a green school jumper or cardigan, they will also need jogging bottoms (or similar), trainers or walking boots and a coat in case it rains.
- We will be putting all lunches into brown paper bags so that we can write children's names onto the bag and recycle the waste from lunch. Please do not put any plastic containers into your child's lunch bag that you want to keep. Children will not be allowed fizzy drinks.
- You must let us know if your child has any symptoms of Covid-19, a high temperature, new continuous cough and a loss of taste and smell; if your child has any of these symptoms they must not attend the trip and will need to take a PCR test.

It's going to be a wonderful day; I think I'm more excited than the children!

Individual school photographs will be taken on Wednesday 29th September, children with brothers and sisters will be taken together and individually.

Thank you for continuing to observe the one-way system at the beginning and end of the school day. We are not seeing high Covid cases in school at the moment therefore we will be letting the children go as the bell rings from today, (not earlier) so please do not come to the school gate too early. If there is an increase in cases locally we will revise this, (please see the Covid outbreak plan on class dojo and the website). The school day ends at 3.20 when the bell goes, the gate to Councillor lane will be opened at 3.15.

I am delighted to let you know that we have appointed a HLTA called Miss Bethany Brownrigg, who will be starting on Wednesday.

School Uniform
