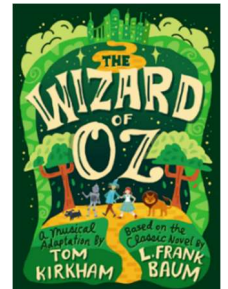
Medical Appointments:
