As you know we have been advised not to have a Christmas Fair due to Covid-19 cases in Stockport. The raffle will be the only way that we can raise money for school this term, so please do buy tickets if you can afford to. They will be on sale from Monday 6th December. Our Key Stage 2 children have been chosen to lead all Stockport schools in the Junior Carol concert on Wednesday 8th December. Unfortunately, parents can't attend this event, but you will be able to join us at All Hallows church on Monday 20th December where the children will be singing some of the carols there.
