Dear Parents/Carers,

We are still receiving notifications of Covid-19 cases from parents, mostly from lateral flow tests, when this is the case we will always notify the classes affected by this.



The future does seem to be more positive and the government are relaxing some of their Plan B measures so I feel that I can now set a date for the delayed Key Stage 2 talent show. (The children will be really pleased about this). The talent show will take place on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> February at 2.15pm. I am still required by Public Health England to carry out a Covid-19 risk assessment for this event and will have no choice but to limit the number of adults who can watch. If you have a child or children who are

taking part in the show you will be issued with one ticket per family. I am really confident that this will go ahead, the Talent Show is such good fun and I'm really looking forward to seeing the wonderful things that the children perform.

Please note that children are not allowed to bring mobile phones into school without permission from me, they should only be in school in exceptional circumstances e.g. if a year 6 child walks home by themselves. In these exceptional circumstances the phone must be handed into the class teacher and locked in the stockroom. The reason for children not having and using phones in school is to keep the children safe from unwanted photographs being taken and the risk of online bullying. School cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to any child's mobile phone and if phones are brought in without permission they may well be confiscated.



From Monday the bike shed next to the park will be open for children to park bikes and scooters in, once children are on the school grounds they need to push their bike or scooter to the shed not ride it. Bikes and scooters are left at the owner's risk, if a bike or scooter is stolen school will not be able to replace it; please make sure that your child has a bike lock as well.

Our lovely School Nurse Tamsin Hobbs will be in school on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> January from 9 o'clock. She can help with lots of things from head lice to toileting, bedwetting to healthy eating. Please do come along and meet her if you have any health concerns about your child, if she can't help she will find someone who can!
