

Pupils with medical needs

- The school's Medicines in School policy is in line with guidance from the Local Authority and can be found on our website.
- School asks parents and carers to inform us if your child has a medical condition we need to address in school, including asthma, and any ongoing treatment. This information is updated annually.
- All Early Years staff and most other staff have completed a 2 day Paediatric First Aid course which is renewed every three years in line with current guidance. We aim for all staff to have this qualification.
- All Staff have regular training and updates of conditions and medication so that they are able to manage medical situations that may arise. This includes annual refresher training on understanding and emergency response to asthma, epilepsy, diabetes and anaphylaxis, including the use of epipens.
- If a pupil has a life-threatening condition that has resulted in their hospitalisation in the previous 12 months, then a detailed Individual Health Care Plan is compiled with the school nurse in consultation with parents and carers.
