

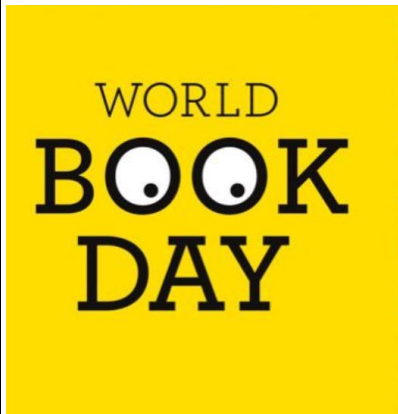
**Ladybridge Weekly News**
