The After School Club is bookable via the School Spider App.

Booking closes 48 hours in advance; this allows us to ensure we have the correct staffing levels.

Cancellations are only refundable if they are cancelled more than 48 hours in advance, except for sickness when they are fully refundable.

School Uniform
