


Ladybridge Weekly News

Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you again for another brilliant Ladybridge week, the beginning and end of day routine is well established and the children are really working well in their bubbles. A wonderful team effort from the children, staff and parents. To make sure that the whole community is safe please do not arrive at school before 8.40 at the start of the day, or before 3.10 at the end of the day. We need to ensure that you are not bunching up on the main road, 2 metres apart is a safe distance for everyone.



As you know we are trying really hard to be a paperless school to avoid any virus spreading, we do however need to send out a paper copy of the flu vaccination form as we need signed consent for this. The nasal flu vaccination will take place in school on Monday 16th November, please fill out the form and return it to school as soon as possible. The nurses that administer the vaccination will have a strict risk assessment to ensure that each child is safe as they are given it. As always we would encourage you to wash your hands or use hand gel before and after you have filled out the form.

For families who use our car park due to a disability or condition, please do not use the two disabled parking bays closest to the school. We have a taxi that needs to use that space for resourced pupils who have significant mobility needs, the taxi needs enough space for children and a wheelchair.

School Uniform
