Dear Parents/Carers,

Our school lunch provider TLC are working really hard and are managing to provide individually packed “hot boxes” for all of our children. Due to rising costs school dinners for children from year 3 to year 6 will increase to £2.25 (from £2.20) - £11.25 per week; nursery meals will increase to £1.10 (from £1.05) - £5.50 per week. This increase will take place from Monday 5th October, if you pay for your meals please calculate this into your payment on ParentPay.
